According to the standard procedure, all papers will be subject to the publisher's evaluation and a journal can be finally confirmed based on the evaluation results.

Each Autex 2023 registration is entitled to have one manuscript to be considered for publication. Full paper will be reviewed by at least TWO independent reviewers. The review reports will be provided to the corresponding author for revision of their manuscript. The conference publication will comply with TTP's [Policy and Ethics guidelines](#), [Publication Policy and Ethics](#), and [Publication Malpractice Statement](#) and [Core Quality Publication Terms](#).

Submission for the authors is open through the [Scientific.Net](https://www.scientific.net) platform from the authors' personal accounts registered with [Scientific.Net](https://www.scientific.net). Every corresponding author who submitted an abstract on the Oxford Abstract platform should have received their login credentials (URL: <https://www.scientific.net>; Username: <Your email address>; and Password) from <https://www.scientific.net>. Please check you Junk Email box if the email is not in your Inbox. Please let us know (email: AUTEX2023@rmit.edu.au) if by any chance you haven't received the login credentials.

The authors should log in to their accounts. After logging in please select «Author» role at the top of the screen to access menus and instructions for uploading your new or revised manuscript, then go to SUBMIT PAPER menu, select the AUTEX title and complete the procedure step-by-step. The authors can also use the direct link for submission <https://main.scientific.net/editing-tool/author/titles/6856/papers/create>; however, they should log in to be able to upload their manuscript.

To allow conference attendees sufficient time submitting their manuscript on the new platform, we extend the manuscript submission due date to 25 June 2023. The conference proceedings will be published after the Autex 2023 conference.

Note, we only use <https://www.scientific.net> for full manuscript submission and publishing conference proceedings, as this is required by the publisher. **Please continue submitting your (revised) abstract (and poster, if you present your poster) through Oxford Abstract platform.** We apologise for any inconveniences.
